Director Mike Macapagal first joined PNOC in 2019 up to 2021, and rejoined the Board in February, 2022. He was a member of the Board of Directors of Clark Development Corporation, and brought with him an impressive and consistent record of building sustainable, scalable, and profitable businesses that have created long-term business and employment opportunities for minority communities in San Francisco Bay Area. Before joining the government, Macapagal was a Corporate Executive who made a mark in the real estate industry as the very first person of color and a member of the minority (a Filipino) to have managed a major title insurance company in the United States. He served as Division President and Country Manager for Stewart Title Company, one of the world's largest title insurance companies. Stewart Title is currently traded at NASDAQ and the NYSE. He studied B.A. History at the University of the Philippines in Diliman, Quezon City, and pursued continuing education in Human Resource Management at U.C. Berkeley. Director Macapagal also taught title insurance and escrow services at Merritt College in Oakland, California, as a guest professor. A native of Olongapo City, "Super Mike," as he is fondly called in his hometown, is also the President & Lead Convenor of SUPERGAPO, a consumer advocate group with over 20K members based in the city. He is the eldest son of former Olongapo City Mayor, Atty. Teddy C. Macapagal.
