# TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS / SCOPE OF WORK

#### **JUSTIFICATION**

An Internet connection is an essential tool for the company's business operation providing a powerful medium for communication within PNOC and with the clients.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

This Terms of Reference (TOR) aims to achieve the following:

- A. Provide the terms and conditions for the bidding contractors in Supply, Delivery and Installation of a dedicated 30 Mbps Leased Line Internet Service connection at the PNOC Energy Supply Base (ESB) in Maniaga, Mabini, Batangas.
- B. Set guidelines on the Financial and Technical aspects of the project

#### **MANDATORY SUBMITTALS**

Bidders are expected to submit the following documents:

- 1. Technical Proposal which includes:
  - A. Company Information
  - B. Technical Specifications
    - 30 Mbps (or better) Dedicated Lease Line Internet connection
    - 99% Service Availability
    - Provide and activate at least eight (8) public Internet Protocol (IP) addresses
    - Detailed Work Plan
    - 24/7 Customer Support
    - Monitoring Tool
    - Business Continuity Plan
- 2. Financial Proposal for the 30 Mbps or better dedicated internet connection where the total budget for the project is at Php300,000.00 pro-rated subject to the start of the actual contract until December 31, 2023.
- 3. Copies of Client Satisfactory Certificates from at least three (3) clients each for the last three (3) years for similar contracts. Similar contract refers to the minimum bandwidth service specified in this project.

#### PROJECT GUIDELINES AND SPECIFICATIONS

The Bidders are expected to submit a complete proposal that shall be in accordance with the detailed technical requirements. If the proposed bid does not comply with the specifications as written, the bidder shall attach to the proposal a complete detailed itemization and explanation for each and every deviation or variation from these specifications. Absence of any such itemization and explanation shall be understood to mean that the bidder failed to meet all details of these specifications.

The winning bidders delivering products or services pursuant to these specifications shall guarantee that they the meet specifications as set forth herein. If it is found that products or services delivered do not meet requirements of the specifications, the bidder concerned will be disqualified.

#### 1. Technical Proposal

It is significant that the Internet Service Provider (ISP) of the proposed system solution has necessary experience and resources required to support PNOC's current and future communications needs. The ISP is expected to submit a proposal which includes the following:

## A. Company Information

- a) Brief overview of the company, including products and services offered, as well as a summary of company history describing how long it has been providing telecommunication solutions and its capability to configure, install, and support the proposed telecommunications solution, as well as its capacity to deliver maintenance services and technical support.
- b) Briefly describe local and remote technical support facilities in system administration, monitoring, operations, repair and maintenance, including the number of support personnel and training and dispatch methods and technician support tools.

### B. Technical Specifications

Each bidder should adhere to the technical requirements stated below:

### 1) System Configuration

i) The internet connection must be a 30Mbps (or better) Dedicated Leased Line Internet Connection wired link from the ISP to PNOC ESB Administration Building with the following Quality of Service (QoS) parameters:

1.	Bandwidth Utilization/Throughput	95% link(s) / route bandwidth utilization during peak hours (TCBH). If on any link(s)/route bandwidth utilization exceeds 90%, then network is considered to have congestion.

2. Broadband Connection Speed	At least 80% (non-dedicated) and 95% (dedicated lines) speed of connection (up/down stream) from ISPs server to the subscriber shall be achieved fulltime (24/7). Connection speed must be measured from the ISP Provider's ONT (Optical Network Terminal) or CPE.	
3. Network Latency	The round trip delay for traffic within the local broadband network from end-user to ISP should be less than 150 ms for 95% peak time	
4. Service Availability	Greater than 99% of the time, network shall be available to the users.	

- ii) The Internet connection must have a Committed Information Rate (CIR) Ratio of 1:1 with at least 99% or better uptime service availability and both the download stream and upload stream is the same as specified at all times.
- iii) Provide and activate at least eight (8) public Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, grouped within the same subnet, for PNOC's public servers and other Internet device/hardware.
- iv) ISP must submit detailed work plan specifying installation design, detailed activities with timeline, connectivity diagram from end user premise up to the existing facility within the area and to determine compatibility with the existing systems and/or building electrical power requirements.
  - (1) Install and terminate block/box with lightning protection unit outside and within PNOC-ESB and premises necessary in establishing connectivity between ISPs network and the Network Terminal of the PNOC-ESB without extra cost to the PNOC.
  - (2) All significant settings and configurations of all devices such as CPEs (modems, routers, network adaptor, network access gateways, and the like) must be provided by the ISP to PNOC including settings and configurations for backup devices.
- v) Provide 24/7 basis hotline technical support assistance in troubleshooting issues affecting the internet connection.

- vi) Provide monitoring tool which should be available online that would show historical and real-time performance of the Internet service i.e. Multi Router Traffic Grapher (MRTG).
- vii) Submit a Business Continuity Plan (BCP) that would provide mitigation controls or action plan in the event a disaster would result the IPs or IP block a Distributed Denial of Service (DDoS) attack and accidentally tagged as SPAM hosts.

## 2. Financial Proposal

The Financial Proposal shall be for the 30 Mbps dedicated internet connection. It should be noted though that the total budget for the pro-rated subject to the start of the actual

contract until December 31, 2023., so that a bidder's proposal, to be considered, should not exceed the bidding price, inclusive of all costs, expenses, taxes, and charges.

The proposals should explain thoroughly and clearly the details of the bid pertaining to the following:

- Price for 30 Mbps or better internet connection;
- Installation, reconfiguration costs, equipment costs, maintenance costs, training costs, and civil works if any should be shouldered by the winning bidder;

### 3. Client Satisfactory Certificate

Should submit copies of Client Satisfactory Certificates from at least two (2) clients each for the last three (3) years for similar contracts. Similar contract refers to the minimum bandwidth service specified in this project.

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### A. Pre-Installation

Provide detailed work plan with timeline specifying installation design, detailed activities, and network diagram showing connectivity.

## B. Actual Installation and Configuration of Internet connection

- 1. Install, configure, and provide a guaranteed 30 Mbps or better bandwidth data line for internet access, to include the mounting and configuration of communication devices and other network devices to connect and enable the data link.
- 2. Subject the connection to a 24-hour Bit Error Rate (BER) test and submit to the MIS unit/Division for approval before proceeding with the installation.
- 3. Maintain a 24-hour fault management call center for trouble calls:
- 4. Provide tools/utilities to monitor bandwidth utilization;
- 5. Provide detailed report on every internet access related incident (downtime, slow/intermittent connection, etc.)
- 6. Single point of contact for sales, billing and support concerns;
- 7. All other activities and provision of required equipment that may be identified during the provision of internet service.
- 8. Provide all significant settings and configurations of devices.

#### **EVALUATION PROCESS AND CRITERIA**

- A. The bidding shall follow the procedures prescribed in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, which took effect 2 September 2009.
- B. The Technical Proposals will be evaluated by the PNOC Bids and Awards Committee, according to the technical requirements stated in part IV.A.
- C. The ISP should have sufficient experience and resources required to support PNOC ESB's current and future communications needs. The ISP must provide the following information:

- 1. Must be an ISP/Telco Company that has its own core data network running over its own domestic fiber optic backbone network.
- 2. Must have the capacity and ability to provide maintenance services and technical support.
- 3. Should submit copies of Client Satisfactory Certificates from at least two (2) clients each for the last three (3) years for similar contracts. Similar contract refers to the minimum bandwidth service specified in this project.

#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- A. The Agreement shall take effect beginning the first monthly bill and may be terminated by either or both parties as provided therein subject to thirty (30) days' prior notification to the party concerned.
- B. The Agreement shall be pro-rated until December 31, 2023 and can be renewed at PNOC's option, subject to evaluation of performance and compliance with the policies of PNOC.
- C. The ISP shall secure all required permits and approvals. However, PNOC shall extend its assistance and will provide full support.
- D. The ISP shall complete the installation, configuration, testing and provisioning of facilities within thirty (30) days from receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).
- E. The ISP shall provide a 24/7 customer and technical support.
- F. The ISP shall provide a free usage and statistic online monitoring tool.
- G. The ISP shall provide PNOC incident reports for Internet outages.
- H. Either party may terminate the Agreement for the other party's breach or non-compliance of obligation by serving the latter a formal written notice thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of termination.
- I. The ISP shall abide by all the applicable safety procedures, policies and standards of PNOC when performing repairs, maintenance and/or installation(s) of equipment within the premises of work. Failure of the ISP to adhere to relevant safety practices shall result in stoppage of work. The ISP shall make the necessary correction(s) of the unsafe acts/practices to the satisfaction of PNOC before the work can be resumed.
- J. Should PNOC wish to upgrade or downgrade its connectivity to a higher or lower bandwidth, or lease additional capacities, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall apply, provided that both parties have agreed in writing to the applicable charges for the upgraded or downgraded capacity, and provided further that applicable procurement rules and regulations are followed.
- K. The ISP of the proposed system solution should have sufficient experience and resources required to support PNOC's current and future communications needs.
- L. If the interruption is attributable to the ISP, as acknowledged by the ISP's Service Report, the ISP shall voluntarily make the appropriate "Rebate" to PNOC without the need to report or claim on the outage. The rebate shall be applied to the next billing month of which total outage shall be cumulatively computed for the month. Outage is considered due for rebates after 24 hours of continuous interruption. Rebate shall be computed using the following formula:

Rebate = No. of Hours of Actual Outage (cumulative per month) x MRC\*

720 Hours

\*MRC is Monthly Recurring Charges; 720 is constant (30 days x 24 hours)

## **Approved Budget**

The approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 300,000.00), inclusive of all costs, expenses, taxes, and charges.

- 7. In case supplier pro forma quotation is submitted, conditions will be governed by the submitted signed Terms of Reference / Technical Specifications Sheet.
- 8. During evaluation of quotation/proposal, the project proponent may require additional documents to verify, validate and ascertain the compliance of the supplier/contractor or consultant.
