RE: VALIDATION RESULT OF PNOC'S 2020 PERFORMANCE SCORECARD

Dear Secretary Cusi and OIC Barleta,

This is to formally transmit the validation result of PNOC's 2020 Performance Scorecard. Based on the Governance Gommission's validation of the GOCC's documentary submissions, PNOC obtained an over-all score of **98.41%** (See *Annex A*). The same is to be posted on PNOC's website, in accordance with Section 43 of GCG Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 2012-07.1

In relation to the grant of 2020 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) to eligible officers and employees, PNOC can grant such incentive only upon receipt of a confirmation letter from the Governance Commission. In this regard, the Board is reminded that any unilateral action to release the PBB before the confirmation will be considered as a violation of the Board's fiduciary duty to protect the assets of the GOCC as provided under Section 19 of Republic Act No. 10149.²
