<p>Whether there are permits, gate passes, work clearances, or other authorizations that will be required prior to project implementation, including the corresponding processing timelines and responsible offices.</p>	<p>During the kickoff meeting with the winning bidder, PNOC GSD will conduct an orientation on the guidelines to be observed during the implementation period, including the application of Permit to Work (PTW) detailing the scope of work, list of manpower, tools, and equipment. These shall be subject to inspection by PNOC security and maintenance personnel, who will also monitor and assist the winning bidder throughout the implementation period.</p>
<p>Whether projects involving the Installation of a Remote Monitoring System, with Delivery Receipts covering items related to a Fire Detection and Alarm System, may be considered as compliant Similar Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) experience for this procurement.</p>	<p>Projects involving only the Installation of a Remote Monitoring System, even with Delivery Receipts for FDAS-related items, shall not be considered compliant SLCC experience unless the submitted documents clearly establish that the completed project involved actual Fire Detection and Alarm System (FDAS) installation works, consistent with the requirements of the TOR.</p>
