**CONTRACT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF BOC ACCREDITED CARGO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Contract made the _____ day of 29 MAY 2026 2026 between:

PHILIPPINE NATIONAL OIL COMPANY (PNOC), a government-owned and controlled corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Presidential Decree No. 334, as amended, with principal business address at PNOC Building 6, Energy Center, Rizal Drive, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, Metro Manila, represented herein by its President and CEO, **FRANZ JOSEF GEORGE E. ALVAREZ**, and hereinafter referred to as the "**PNOC**";

-and-

AMSPEC TESTING SERVICES PTE. LTD., a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at Unit 410 Parqal, Cogon Building, A. Luz Drive cor. N. Abueva Drive, Aseana City, Tambo, Parañaque City, represented herein by its General Manager, **MR. ABNER C. MACASPAC**, and hereinafter referred to as "**CONTRACTOR**";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the PNOC requested for quotations for certain goods and services particularly the Procurement of BOC Accredited Cargo Surveying Services for the Incidental Services for the Procurement of Crude Oil and/or Refined Petroleum Products;

WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines issued Executive Order (EO) No. 110 Series of 2026 declaring a State of National Energy Emergency in relation to the ongoing conflict in the Middle East, and the resulting imminent danger posed upon the availability and stability of the country's energy supply;

WHEREAS, pursuant to EO No. 110, PNOC, in coordination with the Department of Energy (DOE), is mandated to undertake the procurement of required Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) to ensure a timely and sufficient supply;

WHEREAS, the engagement of accredited cargo surveying services is essential to ascertain the discharge volume of fully refrigerated Propane and

Butane cargoes and other related LPG shipments, thereby guaranteeing accurate measurement, international standard compliance, and full operational transparency;

WHEREAS, in order to immediately acquire cargo surveying services, a Negotiated Procurement under Emergency Cases was resorted to pursuant to the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 12009 or the New Government Procurement Act, in the total amount of **EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY PESOS (Php82,320.00)**, hereinafter referred to as the "Contract Price," inclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT) if any, and all applicable taxes, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract. Delivery Schedule shall be aligned with the vessel's movement and discharge schedule at SPI with expected arrival between the period of May 30-31, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, and of the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Unless otherwise stated, terms and expressions used in this Contract shall have the same meanings as those assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract, which form an integral part of this Contract.
2. The following documents as required by the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 12009, and as applicable, shall form part and be read and construed as integral parts of this Contract, viz:
 - i) Mayor's/Business Permit;
 - ii) Notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement;
 - iii) Valid and current Accreditation, license or certification relevant to marine cargo surveying/ inspection services, issued by the appropriate regulatory body or recognized industry organization;
 - iv) Price Quotation and Compliance Form;
 - v) Notice of Award of Contract; and
 - vi) Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity in the RFQ, such as but not limited to the Notice to Proceed.
3. In consideration of the Contract Price of **EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY PESOS (Php82,320.00)**, or such other sums as may be determined in accordance with the terms of the Contract, the CONTRACTOR agrees to deliver and perform the items and related services for the Procurement of BOC Accredited Cargo Surveying Services for the Incidental Services for the Procurement of Crude Oil and/or Refined Petroleum Products described herein in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the Contract and its annexed documents.

4. The PNOC agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum to the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the schedule and manner provided in the Bidding Documents and its annexes.
5. Any dispute, difference, or claim arising out of or relating to this Contract, including its existence, validity, interpretation, breach, or termination thereof, may be submitted to arbitration or other form of alternative dispute resolution in accordance with the applicable law, such as Republic Act No. 9285 (Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004) or Executive Order No 1008, series 1985 (Construction Industry Arbitration Law).
6. Liquidated Damages is at least equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of unperformed portion for every day of delay until actual delivery of performance.
